Klamath County will be having an election Tuesday, November 07, 2023

1. Ballots will be mailed October 18th. Voted ballots must be received in the Elections Office or in any official drop site by 8pm on Election Day.

<u>OR</u>

Ballots can be US Postmarked and can count, if:

- a. Signed,
- **b.** Postmarked on or before Election Day,
- c. Received by the County Clerk's Office within seven days after Election Day
- 2. Official Drop Sites are on the Klamath County Website and on the back side of your ballot. <u>https://www.klamathcounty.org/685/Drop-Sites</u>
- 3. If you have not received your ballot by Wednesday, October 25th, please contact our office to request a replacement ballot over the phone (541) 883-5134, through email <u>elections@klamathcounty.org</u>, or come in and fill out a ballot replacement form and we will hand it to you at the counter.
- 4. The last day to register as a new voter is October 17th. Postmarks <u>DO count</u>. You can register on-line at: oregonvotes.gov or come to the County Clerk's office, 305 Main St. You can update your registration anytime.
